**FELLOW LATIN KINGS OF COMEDY SHARED THE STAGE**  
**AND NOW SHARE A 2008 ALMA AWARD.**

Pasadena Ca – **Alex Reymundo** took home an ALMA Award this past weekend for “Outstanding Comedy Special” for “*Alex Reymundo’s Hick-Spanic Live in Albuquerque*”. Reymundo’s self produced one hour comedy special originally premiered on Showtime in 2007 and then aired again on Comedy Central in 2008. This is the second award that Reymundo has received for Hick-Spanic; earlier this year the program was named “DVD of the Year” by the "home media magazine".

Alex was nominated for this ALMA alongside George Lopez, Carlos Mencia and also competed against himself with two other nominated Showtime Comedy specials in this category for which he served as host and executive producer; “The Latin Divas of Comedy” and “The Payaso Comedy Slam.”

“Although it was officially a tie with George Lopez, it still feels good to just be honored in the same category as my friend, not bad company to share this award with, George is a great inspiration to me”, said the fellow Latin king of Comedy. Lopez was not present to receive his award.

Best known as one of the *Original Latin Kings of Comedy*, alongside **George Lopez, Cheech Marin, Paul Rodriguez** and **Joey Medina**, Reymundo is on a 225 city nationwide tour with Ron White. White is best known from the hugely successful Blue Collar Comedy Tour. White and Reymundo have already performed together to over half a million patrons in the last year and a half.
